Maya's new '**Inclusion collection**' is influenced by the Japanese tradition of **wabi-sabi**, which is the art of finding beauty in imperfection, profundity in earthiness and revering authenticity above all.

The new collection includes beautifully hand-made understated silver and gold objects such as bowls, jewellery and vases.
